

INTRODUCING INTER-FACULTY COURSES

Moving beyond disciplinary boundaries produces an all rounded-graduate. With this aim stake holder meetings were organized to **explore the feasibility for introducing interfaculty courses in curriculum of B.Sc. (Agric) Degree**. Stakeholder input was valuable to identify the disciplinary topics for interprofessional learning and the identified topics were submitted to the Faculty Curriculum Development Committee to finalize the Interfaculty courses for interprofessional learning.

After the recommendation of the Faculty Board and Senate,

- *Entrepreneurial Practices*
- *Public Management*
- *Service Marketing*
- *Organizational change and Development*

Which are courses offered by the faculty of Commerce and Management were incorporated as non-gradual (Non-credit) courses in the third-year study program of the Faculty of Agriculture and included in the undergraduate curriculum (Prospectus 2018-2021).

According to the new initiative student can select one of the four courses based on their interest or availability of any one of the selected courses in a particular academic year and should satisfy the course through the evaluation procedures undertaken by the Faculty of Commerce & Management in order to fulfill the degree program.

An awareness program for the Interfaculty courses was organized in February 2021. Thereafter, students were requested to select their interfaculty course to follow in the 3rd year study programme.
